Training in eBusiness skills

The eBCM-VET project is a vocational education and training project, responding to the multiple challenges office workers and managers are facing when utilizing ICT in business operations and communication.

The specific aims of the eBCM-VET project are to:

- analyze and respond to the need for education and training in the field of eBusiness within target public and private communities, referring to the eBusiness Community Model, eBCM;
- design relevant education and training methods and respective materials and;
- select and utilize in a pilot project the technique and venue for delivering the knowledge and experience to the target group.

The target group is the individuals working in the value chain of trading and distribution of products and services for business use. These are office workers and managers that in one way or another need to use electronic communication and information processing technology in their work or work related activity. The target sectors are companies operating business-to-business (B2B) and business-to-government (B2G), i.e. import, export, manufacturing, warehousing, sourcing and distribution companies. Need analysis published in November

The first assignment in the project is to carry out analysis of the need for vocational training in eBusiness. The findings from the need analysis will be published on the project website in November. The next assignment is to develop training material that will be tested in pilot projects.
